Turn in all Books and Clear Fees

Please be sure to clear all debts you have on file as soon as possible before graduation and other end of the year activities. These may be for library books, textbooks, class activity fundraisers, physical education locks, sports or club uniforms. Graduation tickets, diplomas, transcripts, and report cards will be held for non-cleared debts and you may jeopardize participation in other senior activities. Transcript requests from colleges and universities will not be processed for students with non-cleared debts. Debts owed for any of the areas mentioned above can be paid in the student store.

Eligibility to Participate in Senior Activities

Within three weeks of the event: if you are suspended from school or removed from a school event during school hours or after hours for any reason, you will not be able to attend the senior activity in question. You will not receive a refund for the event missed due to violation of any school rules.

Prom

Prom will be held on Friday, April 20, 2018. Prices are \$150. You are required to be dressed in formal wear going to and coming home from prom. It is suggested that ladies carry a small purse and not bring large bags of any sort. All students and guests will be searched before they enter the bus. Any unauthorized items will be confiscated and the student/guest jeopardizes their participation in the dance. The buses will leave CIMS promptly at 6pm. Students need to arrive at CIMS at 5:00pm. To board the bus you must be on the approved list and have your picture ID. You must ride the bus to and from the prom location. Tickets will only be sold until April 6th, no exceptions! Ticket prices include transportation, DJ, venue, security, decorations, food and beverages.

Cap and Gown Distribution

Cap and gowns along with tassels will be distributed April 6th in the MPR at 9am. Seniors, parents/guardians must have a picture ID in order to pick up their cap and gown. No siblings or friends will be allowed to pick up your cap and gown. If you are not able to pick up your cap and gown on this day, it will be held for pick up in 1301.

Graduation Ticket Distribution

Each graduate will be given 2 tickets for graduation. These tickets will be distributed on May 21st at graduation practice. If graduates need more tickets for graduation, they will be available for sale at \$5 each in the student store starting April 30th.

Graduation Ceremony

Graduation will take place on Friday, May 22, 2018 at High Desert Church Auditorium at 6:00pm.

Seniors report to HDC by 4:00pm. No water will be allowed with the graduate into the auditorium for the official graduation ceremony. All graduates will be searched as they enter. Any unauthorized items (i.e. beach balls) will be confiscated and the graduate jeopardizes their participation in the graduation ceremony.

All family member and guest must have a class of 2018 graduation ticket to be admitted into the ceremony. Every single person, over the age of 2, must have a ticket.

Expect parking difficulties and try to avoid being late.

To ensure a great picture of the graduate receiving their diploma, Grad-Images will be at the ceremony taking pictures. These pictures will be available online approximately 24 hours after the graduation ceremony.

Ceremony Attire

Graduation is a formal and dignified ceremony; the following attire is expected.

Boys: Dress shirt, dress slacks, shoes, socks (no flip flops, tennis shoes, shorts or jeans) Cap and gown and regalia is applicable. (Mortar boards are not to be decorated)

Girls: Dress shoes (no flip flops, tennis shoes, shorts or jeans), appropriate dress or pantsuit. Cap and gown and regalia is applicable. (Mortar boards are not to be decorated)

The following regalia is authorized to be worn on the gowns of those seniors who have qualified:

ASB Executive Board/Senior Class Officers - White Stole AVID – Medallion

CFS – Gold Cord Golden State Merit – White Cord PLTW -Medallion

No other items (corsages, boutonniere, jewelry, sashes such as homecoming, prom, etc.) are to be worn on cap and gown.

Bring no purses, cell phones, corsages, or gifts to graduation. There are no facilities to secure them.

Diploma Distribution

Immediately following the graduation ceremony, graduates can pick up their diploma in the holding room at HDC. Graduates who do not pick up their diploma on the night of graduation may pick up their diploma at the attendance office beginning June 4th.
